Guest Speakers

Susan Jacobucci, Esq Business Administrator, Paulsboro N.J. Subject-GREEN PURCHASING.

Ms. Jacobucci gave our NIGP Chapter 7 members a presentation & handout on understanding the (Green Purchasing & Workplace Accountability. To join Sustainable New Jersey to get update grants information for Green Purchasing. Ms. Jacobucci spoke about the LED lights last longer, for energy saving, Charging Station, Toner Refills, Nao Plastics, Green buildings, Grants out there for it, Park benches. San Diego has the best programs for Electric Vehicles & charging stations. Ms. Jacobucci also raised concerns about the PFAS, Ocean warming Deforesting, Food Waste, Resources-EPA Website–Way to Save Energy. Adopt a Green Purchasing Policy by Resolution. She also provided the members with Purchasing website

Marc Pfeiffer-Assistant Director at Bloustein Local Government Research Center and Principal, PfeifferGov, LLC- Subject- AGGREGATION.

Marc mentioned new book & forms coming that he is in the middle of working on revising the "Yellow Book" for Goods & Services. That the forms are outdated.

Adapt rules-on Aggregation where you bid toilet paper verses paper towels. Bid separately below threshold products. Thru Co-op is fine.

Making aggregation decision NJAC 5.38-8.2c office supplies, copies machines based Contract year-12 months in a contract year. Marc Pfeiffer said PP3 is very clear. Marc Pfeiffer showed samples of fencing and change orders for unforeseen material. On PP3 Class updates. Advise use NJ Co-ops whenever possible or "WHEN IN DOUGHT BID IT OUT"!!.

Marc Pfeiffer said that things happen and for whatever reason, you didn't bid something, and it turns out the initial estimates were too low and what is needed puts you over the threshold. When it does, consider the following:

- If the remaining amount for the year is over the threshold, bid it out.
- If what is estimated for next year **exceeds** the bid threshold, bid it all out.
- The same **is not needed** next year and the additional amount is **less** than 15% of the threshold, use quotes for the remainder.
- The same materials are not needed next year, and the additional amount is **more** than 15% of the threshold, bid it, or ask governing body permission to use quotes.
- If, the **additional** materials for this year **and** next year together are more than 15%, but less than the threshold, ask the governing body for direction to: •

Either bid or get quotes •

Do this by:

- Certifying to the governing body, that there is a need for more;
- Describe how they had been procured during the contract year to date; and
- Obtain a resolution of the governing body approving the purchase
- Do nothing until the governing body acts
